SETTING-UP A REFERENCE FRAME VOCATIONAL DIPLOMA SYLLABUS




Who express needs?

- Employers and employees of the trade,
- Trade associations,
- Vocational training centers, school managers and heads,
- Various other partners.

Carrying out an assessment regarding evidence of needs taking into account existing diplomas.

- The new framework is designed by working groups part of the 19 « C.P.C. » (advisory professional committees) attached to the Directorate of school education.
- This working group is composed as follows:
 - 25 % of members are employers,
 - 25 % of members are employees,
- 30 % of members are from state education (inspectors, teachers, officials in charge of laboratories and research schemes),
- 20 % of members are officials from other ministries.

- Their work consists in listing the different professionnal activities linked to the trade.
- They analyze the different tasks that will/can be alloted to the person with the diploma selected.
- They take into the account the present tasks but also the main possible evolution within 5 years.



- Then the proposal is transformed into a framework which is written (listing the different competencies and knowledge required) by teachers assisted by professionals, in order to meet the goals of the diploma. This group also define the terms and conditions for the final examination.
- The working group is headed by a senior inspector.

IN FRANCE





- Cooperation for the training of learners is mainly worked through :
- internships in hospitals or any other healthcare facilities.
- projects which are led by the learner in the company/healthcare facilities.
 - apprenticeship.



Internships

- For level 3 students (2 years): 14 weeks
- For level 4 students (3 years): 22 weeks

They are the opportunity to develop competencies in different professionnal environments, undertake competencies studied at school, learn more about the organization and functioning of an enterprise...

The content is set in a training agreement previously to the beginning of the intership (by teachers and professionals)

A tutor is appointed and a teacher is in charge of the followup of the learners'activities

An assessment is undertaken at the end of this period and competencies are validated.

Some of these internships are part of the final exam.

A project

 The candidate has to develop a project within the company in order to bring a solution to a problem the organization faces.

 A report is written and the project is presented orally to a teacher and a professionnal.

It is part of the final exam.

Pluridisciplinary projects/professional initiatives

- Level 4 diploma EQF
- Carried out by several teachers with a group of students,
- An issue or a topic is tackled
- Several activities are organized (study visits, workshops, researches, ...).
- Several hours a week are dedicated to this type of project.

apprenticeship

- The learner signs a contract,
- He spends 75 % of his time working in the company,
- 25 % of his time at school.
- He 's paid a wage according to his age, level of education.
- He takes the same exam as other learners.
